

## Terms and Conditions Ashland Theatre Tour 2017

**Tour Price:** A deposit of \$500 reserves your place before the preliminary deposit deadline of May 1, 2017. The balance is due no later than June 15, 2017. Checks should be payable to "New York Theatre Tour," and should be mailed to New York Theatre Tour, 373 Coventry Road, Kensington, CA 94707.

### Summary of Features Included in the Tour

**Price:** Coaching to and from Ashland; best seating for five performances to be selected by tour leaders; five nights double-occupancy hotel accommodations; hotel portage for one piece of luggage per traveler; buffet breakfast daily; lunch en route to and from Ashland; dinner on evening of arrival; day trip, day trip with luncheon; backstage tour; actor seminar; theatre discussion; cancellation protection. Not included in the tour package: Transportation to or from points of coach embarkation; meals in Ashland not here specified; items of a personal nature, such as telephone, laundry, etc. In the unlikely event that a minimum group of 25 participants is not achieved, tour operator reserves the right to pro-rate certain charges to cover group expenses.

**Cancellation Schedule and Penalties:** Deposit, less \$75 service charge, is refundable up to registration deadline, May 1, 2017; cancellation between May 1 and June 15, 2017 will result in forfeiture of deposit. Cancellation after June 15, 2017 will result in forfeiture of entire tour cost. Cancellation must be made in writing and received by tour leader no later than above-referenced dates. Certified mail is suggested for proof of delivery. Cancellation protection is included in your tour price, **once full payment is received.** Cancellation due to covered causes (up to \$2,499, double occupancy, or \$3,116, single occupancy)

less the cost of travel protection premium, will be refunded by the insurer. **Optional tickets are not included in this coverage.** You will be provided a copy of the insurance certificate with your confirmation letter.


